
Martin Bridge Shaping Gauge

I made my shaping gauge from scrap wood, copying three critical contours on Martin bridges. Print this and glue it to a thin scrap of wood (mine is about 1/4" thick). Carefully cut just outside the line, then sand or file down to the line for an accurate final shape.

When printing from your computer, specify Actual Size — do not resize or "scale to fit." Compare your ruler to the 6" scale printed below to know your printout is the correct size. Enjoy this tool, and good luck with your bridge shaping!
